## NEWS SOURCES

### 1) The Haitian Times

- The Haitian Times is an award-winning community news outlet, with focused coverage and analysis on Haiti, and the Haitian Diaspora, in the New York City metro area. In 2012, The Haitian Times transitioned to an online news magazine under the direction of Editor-in-Chief, Manolia Charlotin, with a renewed vision to provide cutting edge news analysis and cultural content for and from Haitians living abroad. Founded in 1999 by former New York Times reporter Garry Pierre-Pierre, the weekly printed newspaper was the first English-language paper dedicated to coverage of Haiti's diaspora.

### 2) The Sentinel

- Promulgates world news about Haiti. Also provides breaking news, and archival information about the Haitian people, politics and economy from news source, *Defend Haiti*.

### 3) The Public Archive

- *The Public Archive* was initiated to serve as an accessible clearinghouse of historical essays, archival sources, and informed contemporary journalism on Haiti. The Public Archive compiles links to documents freely accessible through the digital collections of libraries and repositories as well as open-access online periodicals, academic journals and newspapers.

### 4) Other Sites with Links

- **Kidon Media** Provides a list and links of news sources directly from Haiti.
- **NewsNow** Provides headlines for Caribbean news, including those specific to Haiti.
- **GlobalPost** Links to articles about Haiti from an organization committed to international reporting rooted in integrity, accuracy, independence and powerful storytelling. GlobalPost aims to inform, entertain and fill the void created by what they perceive to be diminished foreign coverage by American media.
- **World Newspapers** Provides links to news sites that provide coverage of Haiti.
